

# Königschießen 2017 (King Shoot)

"50% of all nomination monies will be awarded back as cash prizes"

## About

The current 'King' issues the customary challenge for all competitors to attempt to take his crown in a 12 shot (plus 3 optional 'sighters') 200 yard, traditional German ring target, aperture sight competition

Shooters may compete in their chosen discipline: Open, Black Powder or Service. All competitors are to shoot in a rotational order from either a sitting or prone position, all aiming to achieve the highest score out of 156. Professional markers will judge each shot and score accordingly. The shoot will be conducted under IIRC Königschießen rules (attached) and will apply to all competitors

Saturday 30th December 2017

Nominations close at 9.30am to be followed by a formal welcome

Shooting commences at 10am sharp with the 2016 'King' firing the first official shot of the competition

# Rules for Königsschießen

- 1 Rifles must be pointed up at all times while outside the booth. Bolts/actions must remain open at all times until the command "Your Target" has been given
- 2 All shooters must adhere strictly to the shooting order. Shooters must be ready to enter their booth immediately after the previous shooter exits
- 3 Shooters must occupy the first vacant stool without delay (left handed shooters exempted)
- 4 Shooters must vacate the booth immediately after they have fired
- 5 Each shooter will have 2 minutes to fire their shot from the time "Your Target" is called by the scorer. The two minute exposure will be timed by the scorer, with a single "30 seconds remaining" warning issued before the 2 minutes has elapsed. Time will commence once the scorer calls "Your Target" even if shooter is not in the booth or is not ready to shoot. The only exception will be due to external causes or delays that are not attributable to the competitor
- 6 No rounds (loaded or dummy) may be placed in the action until the command "Your Target" has been called. Closing the bolt, bolt manipulation and/or dry firing is not permitted
- 7 Two malfunctions (either equipment or ammunition) during the competition will be due cause for retirement/disqualification. A misfire or equipment malfunction has to be remedied within the shooters allotted two minutes exposure time or the value of the shot will be forfeit
- 8 Only shooters who have just fired are to have access to the spotting scopes provided
- 9 Shooters must not engage in unnecessary conversation, argue or enter into disputes with the scorer
- 10 Only Shooters waiting to enter the booth and shooters who have just fired are permitted to be forward of the demarcation line

Any rifle fitted with aperture sights may compete in the Königsschießen. Open event. Eagle Eyes and clearing lens are permitted

The Service Rifle Match will be shot under IIRC S.R. Rules

All shots falling within 20mm of the scoring ring will be measured with a 7.62mm gauge

Where practical details will move (right) to the next booth after the lunch recess
