The W Koehler Memorial Ring Trophy sponsored by family of the late W Koehler is shot at 200 yards, and has a long history with the Kapunda Rifle Club. It is a Bisley style of shoot where target rifle (TR-iron sights) competitors share a target and fire in turn. The trophy retains it's roots in target rifle and has not as yet been adapted to F Class. The highest score in the centre ring (50 mm diameter) has a value of 13. Each other score from 12 to 8 is also approx. 50 mm wider than the ring inside it. Only 6 scoring shots counted in each of two rounds giving a possible of 156 for the day. Five target rifle members competed in this year's event, in cooler conditions than the days before. Lindsay Mullins led the day this year taking the trophy. Top off-rifle was D Clarke and also sniper. Next week, Christmas wind-up.
