Weather conditions for the Kanik Trophy at 500 Yards on Saturday 3rd August did not look promising with heavy overcast skies and very dull conditions that made the target aiming marks very hard to distinguish and caused a few problems for the TR shooters but not so for the F Class guys. The highlight of the day was that the infamous Kapunda flags were lying down as if they had been nailed to the poles and they struggled little to get free. The TR shooters came close to getting 'possibles' but missed out by the tiniest of margins whilst the F class shooters were stepping over each other to get onto the mound. In all, four possibles and two double possibles were scored in F Class however this made it difficult for the Captain to work out the trophy winner for the day as Chris Papageorgiou and Trevor Otto both have the same handicap. After deliberations with the Handicapper and Vice-captain, Les announced that Trevor Otto secured the Eddie Kanik Trophy. Tom Litchfield took the snipers in TR with 20.2 and John Hoerisch took "off rifle" with 98.12. F Standard leader was Chris Papageorgiou with Trevor Otto leading F Open and Mat Lagana in F/TR. Next week will be the Kevin Neldner Memorial shoot at 900 yards so please be early to help set up the range.
