Wind was showing predominantly frontal on the flags in the earlier stages, but all competitors were forced to watch the mirage very carefully as wind alternated between left, right and even bi-directional at times, and with deceiving intensities. Most would admit that their scores were not up to usual standards in the deceptively difficult conditions. In reality though, these conditions are quite usual for late summer at Kapunda. Only 3 shooters used all of their handicap or less. Well done Jim Taylor, who took the trophy using 91.8%. Visitors Will and Anthony by all accounts enjoyed the challenge, and left with a better understanding of the need for specialised equipment in long distance target shooting. Queensland visitor Kim Wiseman surprised her coach with a very good score on a TR rifle with bipod. Next week is the final stage of the DRA teams Findlay Shield, at home at 700 yards.
