The W Koehler Memorial Ring Trophy sponsored by family of the late W Koehler is shot at 200 yards, and has a long history with the Kapunda Rifle Club. It is a Bisley style of shoot where target rifle (TR-iron sights) competitors share a target and fire in turn. The trophy retains it's roots in target rifle and has not as yet been adapted to F Class. The highest score in the centre ring (50 mm diameter) has a value of 13. Each other score from 12 to 8 is also approx. 50 mm wider than the ring inside it. Only 6 scoring shots counted in each of two rounds giving a possible of 156 for the day. Seven members competed in this year's event, with warm conditions and buffeting winds. The winner was Dave Shepherd using just 54.49% of handicap. Top off-rifle and sniper was John Hoerisch. Next week, Christmas wind-up.
