The N Tamke Memorial Trophy, together with Stage 6 of the Light River Aggregate were contested on Saturday in cool and sometimes overcast conditions, with fairly consistent right wind. Much better than the disappointing end the previous week when a downpour led to the cancelation of the competition with only a couple of competitors left to shoot their last round. Two possibles from the Kanik camp pointed to the overall high quality of results. More than 2/3rds of competitors finished the day inside their handicap limit.
